World Fest is back with a new twist!

From 2022 - 2025, Albion experienced six different cultures of music through the Arts Midwest program. Twice a year, a band would spend a weeklong residency in Albion to provide free workshops in Marshall Public Schools and community venues like Kids 'N' Stuff Children's Museum, Stirling Books & Brew, Forks Senior Center, and Albion District Library. The week would end with a performance at the historic Bohm Theatre. This unique experience provided hands-on learning and joy through music.

Throughout the Arts Midwest partnership, Albion welcomed the Alaskan Inuit group: Pamyua, Ghanaian musician: Okaidja Arfroso, Brazilian band: Paulo Padiha e Bando, Taiwanese group: A Moving Sound, Jordanian performer: Farah Siraj, and Latin American group: LADAMA. Although the Arts Midwest World Fest concluded this past spring, local community leaders have seen the benefit of experiencing other cultures and learning new music. Sam Porter, local guide, group ambassador, and now lead organizer shared that seeing the engagement from community members, young and old, influenced his passion for the program, and that having accessibility to other cultures is an impactful way to support community growth.



The oldest senior center is Calhoun County is turning 20! The Forks Senior Center (FSC) grew from the passion of a few local seniors wanting a place to connect in 2005. Beginning at the First United Methodist Church, members gathered to play card games and socialize, but the interest and membership grew rapidly. By 2008, the nonprofit outgrew the church and moved to the Crowell Elementary School building. For six years, FSC provided access to health and wellness programs, social activities, and everyday needs for the aging community at this location.





Rooted in community partnerships and access to resources, FSC bridges countless seniors to resources they may not know exist like Carewell Services, Senior Health Partners, and the Community Table of Albion. Resources range from vaccine clinics and health checkups, to transportation, food access, and legal services. Within the building, FSC offers fitness and movement classes for older adults at all movement levels plus daily programs such as euchre, bingo, five crowns, and more. Members build relations with new people, connect with old friends, and just spend time with a supporting community. The Forks Senior Center is truly a necessary hub for any older adult.



Behind the Scenes of the Annual Bids 'N' Stuff Fundraiser

Picture this – a gathering of philanthropic community members on a beautiful fall evening, enjoying drinks and delicious foods, all with the purpose of supporting a beloved local non-profit through bidding on exciting auction items. But what does it truly take to plan a large-scale fundraising event? Kids 'N' Stuff Children's Museum Executive Director, Katie Gigliotti, took a bit of time to explain the work behind the 17th Annual Bids 'N' Stuff Fundraiser.



After speaking with Executive Director, Luann Sommers, I gained some insights into the true impact of the nonprofit. With 415 current members, Sommers sees the importance of movement as you age and the need for socialization. She shared how numerous members find their daily purpose at the center, whether it's brewing the morning coffee or helping at the front desk. One of Sommers proudest aspects is diversity of the membership. People from all walks of life are members, with ages ranging from 60 to 100 and people of different ethnicities and social classes. All are welcomed and encouraged to join.

A 20th Anniversary Celebration is planned for September 12th from 4PM – 6PM with a community open house. Come join the fun!

Planning started just weeks after the 2024 fundraiser was completed. The six volunteer committee members plus Kids 'N' Stuff staff took the time to debrief and understand the strengthens and weaknesses of the completed event. Then in early 2025, the procurement of items and logistics began! It can take months for a single auction item to come to fruition for the event. Story continues on the back.

Every committee tackles the event differently, this year part of the committee tackled auction items, and the others handled the logistics – location, food, drinks, marketing, and more, all while securing sponsors.



But if it's a fundraiser, why do you need sponsors? Planning a quality event with food, drinks, rentals, marketing, and more costs upward of \$10,000 a year. As this is the only fundraiser the non-profit has in a year, it is crucial that the funds raised during the event support the needs of the museum. How do you get the items for the auction?

Auction items are a mixture of donations and purchased goods. Numerous come from the committee and board's personal connections whether they are a business owner or know someone willing to support. Various local businesses support the endeavor with donations. Determining what is included in the auction is fine balance between baskets and physical items to experiences.



Wonderland This year, you can expect the same amazing experience filled with wonder, just in a new venue! With the changes at Stoffer Plaza, the committee

had to pivot locations to the Science Atrium at Albion College, on Saturday September 13th from 6PM – 9PM. Expect great food, fun games, and exciting auction items.
