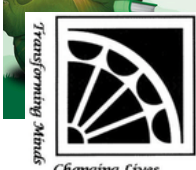

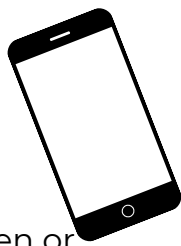


Kids 'N' Stuff Children's Museum - New! Kids Summer Camp

New! Tips & Tricks with Tech Savvy Seniors



April Showers bring May flowers! Spring has sprung which means it's time to start on some Spring cleaning. No, not just your house, cleaning out your phone too! Unused apps take up storage on your phone and make it harder to take pictures and download apps that you actually need.

How to delete apps from your phone:

- Option 1 (Android).
1. Find your settings app.
 2. Scroll or use the search bar search to find the section titled "Apps." (You should see a long list of all of the apps on your phone, arranged alphabetically).
 3. To delete an app, click on the app you want to delete.
 4. Press the "Uninstall" button, usually located between "Open" and "Force Stop" buttons.
 5. Repeat this process for all apps you want deleted.

Option 2 (Apple and Android).

1. Find the app on your home screen or search in your app App Library (found by swiping left on the last page of your home screen)
2. Hold down on the app for about 2 seconds until a list comes up.
3. Press the "Delete App" button (typically in red, at the bottom of the list)
4. A box will pop up asking if you want to delete this app, press the "Delete" button (typically found in red on the right side)
5. Repeat this process for all apps you want deleted.
