Calhoun County is excited to launch the groundbreaking Rx Kids program in participating communities including Albion! Rx Kids is a maternal and infant health program that provides direct cash support to pregnant mothers and families with newborns, no strings attached. The program is designed to reduce infant poverty, improve birth outcomes, and strengthen families during the most critical early stage of life.

In Albion, Rx Kids will provide a one-time payment during pregnancy to support prenatal health and preparation for a baby, and monthly cash payments during a baby's first 6 months of life to help families meet basic needs such as housing, food, transportation, childcare, and utilities. By reducing financial stress early on, Rx Kids strengthens families, improves health outcomes, and supports brighter futures for children.

On Saturday, June 6th at 6PM in Goodrich Chapel on the Albion College campus, experience dance and movement in Albion like you never have before.



Thirteen amateur and professional dancers from the Albion community, HBY Ensemble from Detroit, and Demetrius Klein Dance Company from Hamilton, Ohio, will express over 160 years of combined dance experience with new choreographic work from Artistic Director, Kristy Clement.

While planning this collaborative evening, Clement shared that Fluence Arts envisioned an expressive way for the community to not only experience dance but for all skill level to be a part of it. Clement was a student of Missy Wyss, the founder and director of the former Albion College Dance Program, and the namesake of the celebration. Clement emphasized that Wyss played a major role in her dance career, sharing her mindset that "dance brings people together that wouldn't cross paths otherwise. Dance allows human expression in one of the most primal forms, in ways that words fall short. All people can dance, not just experienced professionals."

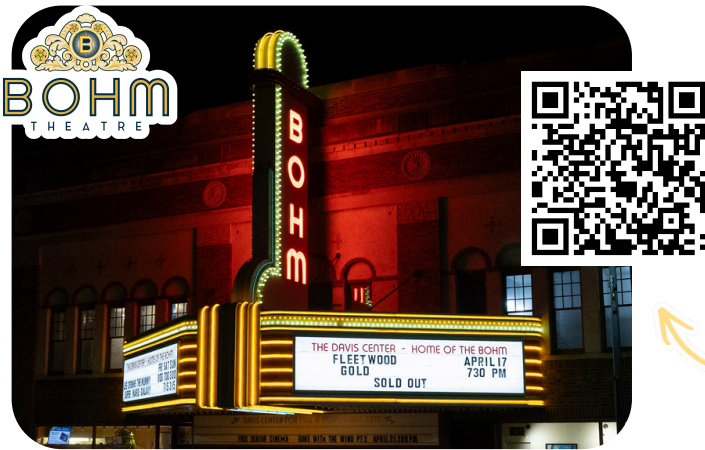

Collaboration Corner, a past endeavor between the City of Albion and Albion College, is getting an exciting facelift! The little pocket park at the corner of East Michigan Ave. and Monroe St. is being re-landscaped using all native plants and trees to become the future site of the Robert Holt Memorial. When this upgrade is complete the memorial, consisting of a dedicated bench, informational plaque and potential sculpture, will be installed to honor the Albion citizen and World War II veteran who was widely known and loved in our community. Robert Holt's stepdaughter, Nora Jackson, and Derrick Crum are heading up the fundraising efforts to create a statue for the memorial.
