

Exposure to lead can affect nearly every system in the body, and frequently goes unrecognized, which can potentially lead to serious health issues.

If you live in the City of Albion and your household includes a child under 19 years of age or pregnant person enrolled in Medicaid, you may be eligible or a free home plumbing assessment.
